Fishing

The main attraction at Rainbow King Lodge will always be the fishing. Rainbow King has an extremely unique fishing program that offers private access to many of the region's finest streams and rivers. It's an Alaskan fishing experience solely available through Rainbow King Lodge. Rainbow King Lodge maintains the exclusive access to over 110 square miles of uplands in Bristol Bay which gives us much better access to some of the best streams in the Iliamna Region. We're located in the heart of Alaska's renowned trophy Rainbow Trout region. In addition to the region's famous rainbow trout, our Alaska fishing guides will help you find the best places to locate many other species, including:

- Arctic Grayling
- Pacific halibut
- Dolly Varden
- Northern pike





At least one of the targeted salmon species will be available at all times of the season, allowing you to plan your trip to include the species of your choice:

- King Salmon run from mid-June to late July
- Sockeye Salmon run from late June to early August
- Silver Salmon from early August to end of the season in September

While all Salmon species will never run at the same time, the best overlap of runs will occur from mid to late July.

Rainbow Trout are available throughout the season, with the largest and most plentiful being available during June and mid-August through September. Arctic Grayling fishing is always excellent, as is the Dolly Varden/Arctic Char and Northern Pike.

We keep several skiffs at Calypso Bay on the coast for those that might want to enjoy the challenge of fishing for Pacific Halibut. Calypso Bay is relatively shallow by halibut standards, so huge weights and strong currents are not a problem. We have all the needed deep sea tackle for a day's fly-out to Calypso Bay.

Lodging

The lodge compound sits on the shore of Lake Ilimana. There are thirteen guest rooms that accommodate sixteen guests each week. There is a main lodge with dining and common room, and two amazing massage chairs. The recreation center has HDTV, fireplace, pool table and card tables. The rec center is where guests meet each evening before dinner for hors d'oeuvres and to discuss the next days agenda.

Once you arrive, you'll settle into our five-star lodge. The rooms have private baths, custom made mattresses that are topped with the highest-quality Pima cotton bedding. Rainbow King Lodge stands out among other Alaska lodges by providing you with a top-notch experience whether you're fishing, dining or unwinding with your fellow sportsmen by the fire.





Float Planes

Rainbow King's aircraft include two six-passenger deHavilland Beavers and one ten passenger deHavilland Turbine Otter.

- N926RK is a 1953 fixed wing single engine Beaver model U-6A.
- N927RK is a 1956 fixed wing single engine Beaver model DHC-2 MK. I(L20A).
- N947RK is a 1955 fixed wing single turbo prop engine Otter model DHC-3.

These aircraft have been refurbished, are carefully maintained by an onsite mechanic and are some of the best float planes flying in Alaska today.



2025 Trip Rate

Rainbow King starts in June each season and extends into September. The Rainbow King Lodge all-inclusive six-days and six-nights 2024 Alaska fishing package is \$12,500 per person. Groups of 8 or more all-inclusive Alaska fishing packages are \$12,300 per person.

Not Included

Airfare to and from your home to Anchorage and to and from Anchorage to Ilimana, Gratuities (10 - 15% of trip cost), Bed Tax, Liquor, Fishing License & King Stamp. Chest waders are the one fishing item you will need to bring or purchase on-site.

The balance for your trip is due at the completion of your trip. We accept payment by either personal check or credit card.

Travel Information

Rainbow King Lodge is located 190 miles southwest of Anchorage on the shores of Lake Iliamna, Alaska's largest lake.

You will fly into Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport. From there you will need to take a cab or Uber to Merrill Field and the Lake Clark Terminal (2541 Merrill Field Dr., Anchorage, AK). We work directly with Lake Clark Air transporting guests between Anchorage and Iliamna at set times on Sunday. You must arrive at Clark Air at Merrill Field in Anchorage by 4 PM to catch the 4:30 PM flight to the lodge, (from Anchorage to Iliamna). On Saturday (from Iliamna to Anchorage), the flight leaves Iliamna at 6:00 PM. Plan your departure from Anchorage accordingly. This schedule allows all of our guests to arrive and depart at the same time. If other flight arrangements are necessary, please contact us in advance, and we will do our best to accommodate you.

Private aircraft can fly directly to Rainbow King. Iliamna Airport (PAIL) has two paved runways with one over 5,000 feet and RNAV GPS approaches to all runways.

Alcoholic Beverages

Iliamna is a dry village by law, and it's illegal for us to sell or provide liquor. However, guests are free to bring their own spirits and we furnish whatever mix you may need, and serve your wine at dinner. Anyone is free to tend the bar and you're sure to have a great time getting to know your fellow guests in the comfort of our lodge.
